### Technical requirements: Page format and size:

- Entries should be in A4 format with portrait orientation.
- Materials should be prepared in Microsoft Word format (\*.doc or \*.docx).

### Length:

- The volume of the work should be from 3 to 5 pages inclusive.
- Title.

### Abstract and keywords:

- The abstract should contain 100 words.
- The number of keywords should be from 3 to 10

### Structure:

- General essence of the problem (introduction).
- Analysis of recent research and publications.
- Formulation of the purpose of the article.
- Presentation of the main material (research results).
- Conclusions.
- List of references.

**Text formatting:**

- Use Arial font size 11.
- Line spacing should be 1.5.
- Paragraph indentation is 1.25 cm.
- Top, bottom, left and right margins are 2.0 cm.
- Do not number the pages.

**List of references:**

- The list of references should be given at the end of the paper in alphabetical order.
- Each source used should be referenced in the text in parentheses, for example: (Ivanov, 2024).

**Formulas:**

Formulas must be typed using the formula editor in Microsoft Word for Windows.

**File name:**

The names of the submitted files should correspond to the surname of the author of the publication, for example, "Surname\_abstracts".

**Figures and tables**

Figures and tables should be placed immediately after the text where they are first mentioned.

The font size for tables and figures is 10 points.

**Formatting the list of references:**

The list of references should be formatted in accordance with the American Psychological Association's style (APA 7 style).

Please check your paper for compliance with these requirements before submission. Adherence to these technical requirements will facilitate the perception of your work and contribute to the creation of a single standard for all conference participants.

When calculating the number of pages to pay for the publication, the number of pages occupied by the abstracts prepared in accordance with the editorial requirements for the design of materials is taken into account, while the publication may have a different number of pages in the collection of materials;
